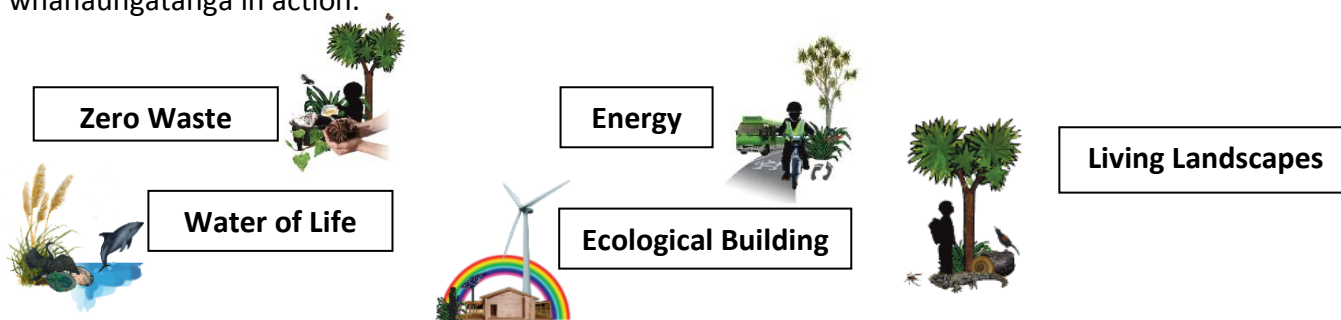


ES Hui – your choice @ Eskdale School

How to get there: Eskdale School is at 324 Hill Road, Bayview. You can either come off the main Napier – Taupo Road or travel through the township of Bayview up and over Hill Road and the school is on the right. **Please think sustainably and if you have a school van, you may be able to pick others up on the way.**

(Every school that buddies up for transport will receive a \$50 travel subsidy).

What you need to do: Complete the registration form below, scan and email back **by Friday 5 May**.

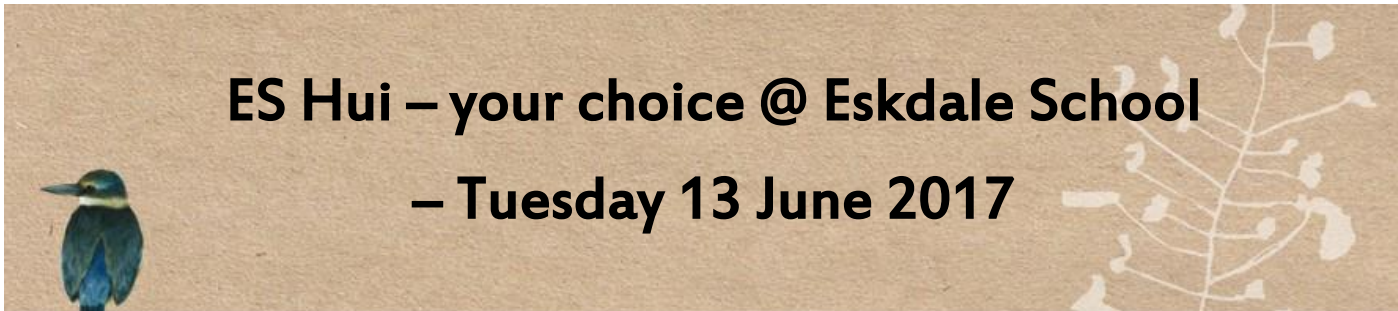
